

Seiei Kan Ju Jutsu Vols. 1& 2 The simultaneous publication of these two volumes marks an important point in the progress of what is probably best called modem Jujutsu in that it is a scientifically based form, which, in the admission of the book's authors, is, "always working to find a better way to do ju-jutsu."

Certainly a lot has gone into the planning and publication of the books which are packed with techniques drawn in the most part from classical jujutsu, but clearly with the inclusion of a lot of Judo and karate techniques as well.

Both volumes are well-organized and comprehensive. I particularly liked the information that they present in the form of a style curriculum and the glossary, which is very easy to follow, even for entry level students.

The authors deserve a note here. Donald Madden 's career in the martial arts is certainly a long one. The trainer of a former WUKO champion; USA Jujutsu team coach in Denmark 1993; USAKF Man of the Year in 1985 and founder of over 200 clubs in the United States.



The books certainly fill a need, are well-priced and easy to follow. The techniques are demonstrated as practical applications, which is a good way of getting the message across. For example, to demonstrate *kote gaeshi*, a knife attack to the chest is shown; against a double wrist grip from behind, *kote hineri*.

This is far superior to demonstrating a technique in isolation, and asking the reader to use his imagination to determine in which sit-



uations it would be useful and effective.

Readers will find the admixture of judo and karate techniques very interesting and clearly very eff ective. While many of the modern derivations of Jujutsu shun striking techniques, Seiei Kan Ju Jutsu is clearly more interested in what works rather than what looks good, and for this the authors are to be congratulated.

Anyone contemplating a course in Ju Jutsu, or wishing to have more general information on the art, look no further.
